ThriveWell Cancer Foundation is a local non-profit organization dedicated to finding a cure for cancer by funding cancer research, providing patient support and offering programs to improve the quality of life for patients and their families. ThriveWell Cancer Foundation was founded in 2007 with the DIVA program which provides free exercise, nutrition and wellness classes to breast cancer patients and survivors. DIVA was developed because research shows that breast cancer patients who follow diet and exercise guidelines can reduce their risk of recurrence by up to 50 percent.

Forté Rehabilitation & Wellness Center has been working closely with ThriveWell Cancer Foundation by helping develop and host DIVA classes. As a physical therapy center that specializes in oncology rehabilitation, we have seen the difference ThriveWell can make during a patient's journey through cancer. We believe in everything that ThriveWell stands for, which is why we are pleased to present our annual production to raise money for such an innovative organization.
